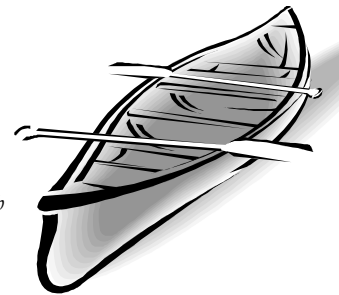


Kiwanis Youth Outdoors Day

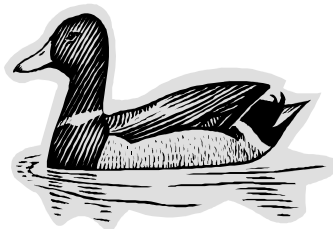
